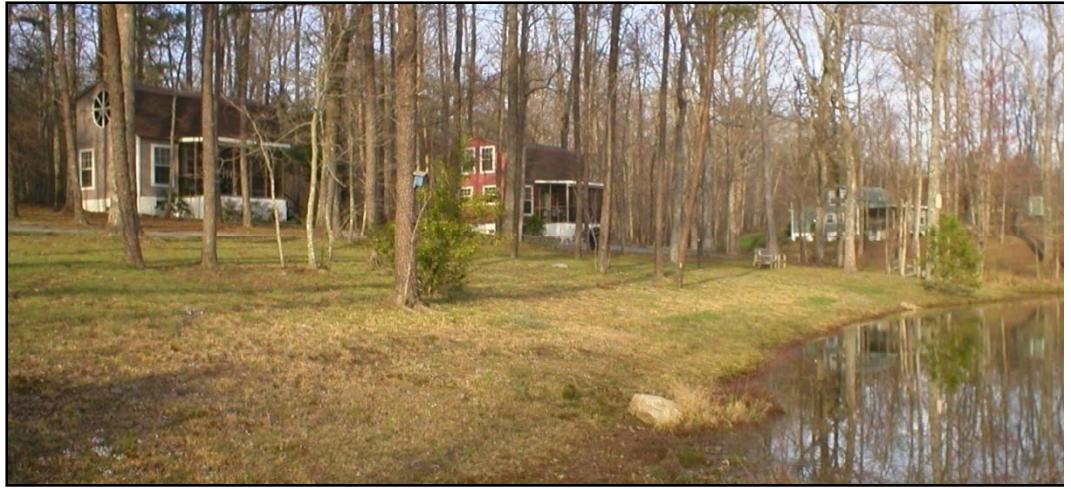


# Building Memories for a Lifetime . . . *and beyond!*

Have you ever wanted a place of your own where you could take the family and get away from the everyday demands of life?

Imagine a place where you can sit atop a rock bluff overlooking a mountain stream, and ponder what is really important in life. Where you can end a day of biking and swimming, relaxing around a bonfire roasting marshmallows. We have just the place, and you can build memories that will last for generations. It is beautiful and peaceful with thousands of acres of valleys, trails and streams just waiting for you to explore. And most importantly, any family can afford it. Let me tell you a little about The Wilderness.

In April of 2004 my wife and I opened a Christian retreat on land adjoining the 14,000 acre Little River Canyon National Preserve, in Mentone, Alabama atop Lookout Mountain. The purpose of the retreat is to provide a facility in an environment so beautiful that those visiting would be drawn to the One who created such beauty. Since then we've had the privilege of hosting youth groups, Sunday school classes, deacon retreats, women's retreats, church picnics, and baptisms. The property has four cabins, a soon-to-be completed 5000 square foot chapel/bunkhouse, a pond and farmhouse.



After much prayer, we've decided to lease the cabins. The cabins are fully furnished and have hot tubs on covered porches. With the lease comes use of the pond, a great bonfire pit, miles of secluded hiking/mountain bike/horseback riding trails, a crystal clear swimming hole on the Little River, volleyball, horseshoes, and huge game field. This also makes great financial sense for families. The cabin leases start at only \$25 per night.

Besides family vacations, possible uses for the cottages are: giving your pastor and his wife a few days together, marriage enrichment weekends, missionaries on furlough, deacon retreats, church leadership planning retreats, mother-daughter or father-son retreats . . . there are many possibilities. You could even split a week by spending Thu.-Sun. on a family vacation then giving your Pastor Mon.-Wed.

Shown below is how the opportunity works out. Each year you'll receive one week (between August and May) at The Wilderness. Every other summer (between May and August) you'll have a three or four night stay. The summers when you don't have cabin nights you're welcome to camp. At the end of each 10-year period, your family can renew for an additional 10-year period at similar terms. The Wilderness can become a part of your family tradition without the huge expense of buying your own cabin! If you want to cut costs even further, you can split the costs between two families and still have three vacations every four years! You can cancel at any time after the first year.

### Chapel/Bunkhouse
